Our Enquiry Theme this half term is 'Who will help me?'. We will begin by considering which emergency services can help us and how they can help us. We will learn about paramedics, police officers, and firefighters. Hopefully our local firefighters will be able to visit us in school during this half term. Following on from this we will learn about "Supertato".

During the last two weeks of this half term, we will be preparing the children for moving to Foundation Two. During this time the children will be voting for what they would like to learn about – once they have decided we will let you know! On Tuesday 23rd July we will taking the children to Rand Farm - more details will follow shortly, but we think it will be a great way to finish our learning about what we might find in the garden and who can help us.

Who can help me?

Help!

There are lots of people near that can help us. When there is an emergency, help can be found by dialing 999. There are three services that can help in different ways. These emergency services are ambulance, police, or fire.



Key Vocabulary

999 The number to ring if you need help.

Emergency An urgent or sudden event that needs fast action to help.

A **paramedic** helps people who are hurt.

A **fire fighter** helps if there is a fire.

A **police officer** helps if people are lost or not following rules.

Superhero A story character who can help.

Superhero help

A superhero is a character in a story that can help.



Supertato is a potato superhero who tackles the Evil Pea villain.

Phonics

During phonics we will continue to follow Letters and Sounds Phase 1. We will be learning about rhythm and rhyme, alliteration, voice sounds, and oral blending.



We will learn a new nursery rhyme each week.

Maths and Understanding the World

We will continue to develop our counting skills, and also compare groups of objects. Following on from this we will explore 2D shapes and weighing. During Explore and Investigate time we will explore different materials and investigate forces.

Muddy Explorers

Muddy Explorers will take place every week. The children will need to bring a waterproof coat on their day as well as some named wellington boots and sun hat so that we can go outside whatever the weather!
