Enquiry Theme – Children's Choice

As many of you may be aware for the final two weeks of term we allow the children to choose the final enquiry theme of the year. The classes have discussed various themes, and decide what they would like to learn about.

Blue Room (F2) "Who is the Gruffalo?"

Blue Room are going to read the story of "The Gruffalo", use puppets and masks to retell the story, and paint pictures of the Gruffalo.

Rainbow & Yellow Rooms F2 "What can fly?"

The classes will be reading a story about a hot air balloon, and imagining where they would go. Then they are going to make kites, and take them outside to see if they will fly.

Orange & Green Rooms (Y1) "What is a Mythical Creature?"

The children will be looking at the story 'Dragon Machine' by Helen Ward, and writing descriptions of dragons. They will also be making dragon sculptures using clay, and decorating these ready to display at the end of year art exhibition.

Red & Violet Rooms (Y2) "How would you use a Magic Paintbrush?"

Y2 will be reading the story 'The Magic Paintbrush' by Julia Donaldson. They will be thinking about how they could change the world in positive ways, and also going outside and making our own magic paintbrush using natural materials, then making a magic paintbrush mixture.



The "FSA Friday Fayre"

A reminder that on Friday, 19 July, the FSA are holding a "Friday Fayre" on the school playground from 3.30pm to 4.30pm. There will be a cake stall, a pre-loved uniform stall, a pre-loved children's book stall, and a "teddy tombola".
