Form for Leave of Absence During Term Time

In August new regulations came in to place for Pupil Attendance. The school's policy can be seen on our website www.lwi.org.uk in the "Information" tab, under "Policies". The regulations make it very clear that absence during term time will only be granted in exceptional circumstances, and that unauthorised absences of ten sessions or more in a rolling period of ten school weeks may lead to a penalty notice (fine) being issued. If you do need to take your child out of school during term time please complete the Holiday Request Form which is attached to this newsletter.
