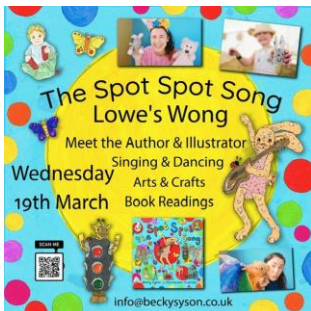
Easter Hat Parade
