Students and Trainees in School

Next week we are lucky enough to have work experience students from The Minster School helping in school. It is lovely to support their placements, and the children really enjoy having the students in their classrooms.

Next week Yellow Room are also welcoming back Miss Simm, a trainee teacher from Nottingham Trent University. She will be working alongside Mrs Segasby until June.



PE Kits and Ball Skills Kits

On the day of their Ball Skills lesson with Natalie, please can children come to school in an outdoor PE kit (a t-shirt, joggers, their school jumper and trainers). The days of the lessons are as follows:

Monday – F1a (Blue Room), Red Room & Violet Room

Wednesday – Orange Room, Green Room, Yellow Room & Rainbow Room

Friday – F1b (Blue Room)

Children also need an indoor PE kit in school for their other PE lesson, this should be shorts and a t-shirt (any style or colour) in a small bag, which will stay in school until the half term holiday.

Children in Blue Room do not need an indoor PE kit as they only have one PE lesson a week.

On PE and Ball Skills days, **long hair should be tied up and all jewellery removed or taped up**, thank you.



Book Bags, Reading Books, and Reading Awards

Please make sure that your child brings their Book Bag and Learning Journal to school every day. At the front of the Learning Journal there is a space for you to write regular "Going Home Arrangements" and also a section letting you know on which day your child will do Ball Skills and PE. When your child reads their reading book with you at home, please make sure that you record this in the "Reading at Home" section for that week. There is also a section where the teachers will let you know what reading your child has done in school, and a place for you to write any messages from home (for example play dates or changes to usual collection arrangements). We will be continuing with our Reading Awards for reading at home this term, there are three awards, a Bronze Award for reading 25 times, a Silver Award for reading 75 times, and a Gold Award for reading 130 times. The children receive their bookmarks in assembly (usually on a Friday) and their names are recorded on our Facebook page.



Water Bottles

Please can the children bring a water bottle to school every day, this should be filled with water (not squash or juice). School water bottles are available from the Office, or children may choose to bring a bottle from home if they prefer. Please make sure that the bottle they bring is one that they can open easily themselves, and is clearly labelled with their name, thank you.



Nuts in school

Please can parents and carers be aware that we have several children in school who are allergic to nuts. We therefore ask that children do not bring any nuts, or foods containing nuts, in their packed lunches or snack, thank you.
