Nuts in school

Please can parents and carers be aware that we have several children in school who are allergic to nuts. We therefore ask that children do not bring any nuts, or foods containing nuts, in their packed lunches or snack, thank you.



School Times

Please could I remind parents and carers that school starts at **8.55am** each morning (not 9am!). We open the classroom doors at 8.50am each morning, and for security reasons they are locked at 9am. If you arrive after 9am, please bring your child to the School Office. School finishes at 3.30pm each day.



Lunchboxes

One or two parents have asked us about “rules” for packed lunches. As a “Healthy School” we ask that the packed lunch is equivalent to the school meal, so these are the guidelines we ask you to try and follow:

- Please avoid nuts, or nut products, as we have pupils with allergies in school.
- Please do not send sweets or chocolate bars (although a cake or a chocolate biscuit is fine as a “pudding”!).
- Please try not to send potato crisps, but choose a “healthier” alternative.
- The children do not need to bring a drink as water is provided.



Warm Weather

As the weather is getting warmer and sunnier again, please will parents and carers make sure that the children have a water bottle in school every day – this should be filled with water (not squash or juice). School water bottles are available from the Office, or children may choose to bring a bottle from home if they prefer. Please make sure that the bottle they bring is one that they can open easily themselves, and is clearly labelled with their name.

It would also be useful if the children could bring a sun hat to school to wear at playtimes, (also clearly labelled with their name!), thank you.
