### Lunchboxes

Lovely as the current spell of warm weather is, there are implications for parents and carers with regards to their children's lunchboxes. Please could I ask parents and carers to try to use insulated lunchboxes, with ice-packs inside to keep the food cool. We do store lunchboxes out of direct sunlight, but we do not have the capacity to put them all in a fridge. Parents should also consider perhaps sending "low-risk" foods (so no meat fillings in sandwiches) whilst it is so warm. Our catering service do offer a "pick and mix" selection which is a choice of a filled roll and side salad and a pudding, this is included in the Universal Infant Free School Meal offer and might be a possible alternative for those children who do not want a hot lunch.



### Information Evening for Parents & Carers of F1 (Blue Room)

On Wednesday, 25 June we are holding an Information Evening at 5pm for parents and carers of children who are starting full-time school in September. During this meeting you will have the opportunity to look around our classrooms and speak to the teachers before your child visits their new class the following week. You will also be able to see the type of activities that your child might participate in when they are in Rainbow Room or Yellow Room. There will be a short presentation about learning in the Foundation Stage from Mrs Macintyre, and you will also have the opportunity to ask any questions that you may have. If possible, please do not bring other siblings to that meeting or it will be hard to fit everybody in the classrooms!
