School Meal Arrangements for "Special" Days

Please will parents and carers make sure they update the school meal ordering system (IFG) for any visits that the children are going on this half term. Further information about each visit is below:

Y2 visit to the Junior School on Monday, 30 June

Please will parents and carers of Y2 children make sure that they have cancelled their child's school meal for Monday, 30 June.

When the children are at the Junior School they may have a school meal or take a packed lunch. If they are having a school meal, they do not need to pre-order, they can choose on the day. The menu for Monday is:

- pork meatballs in a tomato sauce with pasta shapes, vegetable sticks & garlic bread
- jacket potato served with cheese, baked beans, or tuna mayonnaise and a mixed salad
- the pudding is gingerbread cookies

If the children bring a packed lunch they will still be able to eat with their friends. We have already notified the Junior School of any dietary requirements.

Mental Health Workshops for Y2 Children

As a school we are really pleased to be involved in a project run by the Nottinghamshire Mental Health Support Team. This team links directly with Nottinghamshire CAMHS teams and provides in-school sessions to promote positive mental health. They are an early intervention mental health and wellbeing service for schools, aimed at providing support for children, young people, and families around low-level emotional wellbeing needs, such as anxiety, low mood, managing emotions, and sleep.

As part of the support we receive in school from the Mental Health Support Team (MHST) the Y2 children will be taking part in a workshop to support their transition to the Junior School. This will be led by Mrs Taylor Irving, who is a support worker trained in leading workshops for children. The children will have a 45-minute session on Tuesday, 1 July where they will use a story to open discussions about worries. This will include the key message that it is OK to feel worried, and will also give the children opportunity to discuss their feelings about transition and offer them some practical strategies for coping with change.



Y1 Visit to Bestwood Park – Tuesday, 1 July

On Tuesday the Y1 children are going on their visit to Bestwood Park. The children need to come to school in suitable clothing for a day outdoors and bring a rucksack containing their lunch and a water bottle.
