Foundation Stage visit to Rand Farm Park

On Tuesday, 22 July, Blue, Yellow and Rainbow Rooms are all going on their visit to Rand Farm Park. We will open the classroom doors a few minutes early on Tuesday to allow the children to go to the toilet and get ready for the visit.

The children do not need to wear school uniform for the visit, and should wear suitable footwear for walking around the farm. The weather forecast for Tuesday is very variable, and so they will need both a sunhat and a waterproof coat with them! Please can they also bring a rucksack as they will need to carry their lunch with them during the day. You can either provide a packed lunch from home, or you can choose one of the 'Pick and Mix' options on your child's IFG School Meal Account. Please log on and amend your child's meal account accordingly for Tuesday. The children still need to bring their own drink and may bring an extra snack if they would like to.
