Enquiry Theme – What makes our locality amazing?

History – Remembrance Day

- Know that periods in time have similarities and differences to the present time and to make connections with the past.

Key vocabulary: Remembrance Day, poppies, soldiers, World War 1.

Geography – Map work

- Know that a map can show locations of features and routes.
- Know that a map has a key with basic symbols.
- Know how to devise a simple map and to construct basic symbols in a key.
- Know how to use aerial photographs and plan perspectives to identify human and physical features and landmarks.


Key vocabulary: Virtual map, aerial photographs, route, symbol, orientation.



Computing - Presenting Ideas

- Know how a story can be presented in different ways.
- Know how to make a quiz about a story or class topic.
- Know how to make a fact file on a non-fiction topic.
- Know how to make a presentation to the class.

Key vocabulary: E-book, fact file, fiction, non-fiction, mind map, presentation, quiz, node.



PSHE - Valuing Differences

- Know how to identify some of the physical and non-physical differences and similarities between people.
- Know how to use words and phrases to show respect for other people.
- Know how to identify people who are special to them.
- Know how to explain some of the ways those people are special to them.
- Know how to explain a person's behaviour can affect other people.
- Know how it feels to be part of a group.
- Know how it feels to be left out from a group.
- Know how to identify groups they are part of.
- Know that strategies can be used for helping someone who is feeling left out.
- Know how to describe acts of kindness and unkindness.
- Know how these impact on other people's feelings.
- Know that kind words and actions can show to others kindness.
- Know how to show acts of kindness to others in school.
- Know how to demonstrate active listening techniques (making eye contact, nodding head, making positive noises, not being distracted).
- Know that there are strategies for dealing with a range of common situations requiring negotiation skills to help foster and maintain positive relationships.

Key vocabulary: difference, self-esteem, diversity, respect, tolerance, emotions, support network, resolution.
