PE Kits and Ball Skills Kits

On the day of their Ball Skills lesson with Natalie, please can children come to school in an outdoor PE kit (a t-shirt, joggers, their school jumper and trainers).

Water Bottles

Please can the children bring a water bottle to school every day, this should be filled with water (not squash or juice). We do still have a few School water bottles available from the Office, or children may choose to bring a bottle from home if they prefer. Please make sure that the bottle they bring is one that they can open easily themselves, and is clearly labelled with their name, thank you.



Nuts in school

Please can parents and carers be aware that we have several children in school who are allergic to nuts. We therefore ask that children do not bring any nuts, or foods containing nuts, in their packed lunches or snack, thank you.



Y1 Visits to Field Farm – Monday, 20 April & Tuesday, 21 April

On Monday or Tuesday the Y1 children are going on their visits to Field Farm. **Orange Room** are visiting on Monday, and **Green Room** are visiting on Tuesday.

The children need to come to school in suitable clothing for a day outdoors and bring a rucksack containing their packed lunch and a water bottle. If you want to order a school packed lunch for your child, this needs to be done by midnight on Saturday via the IFG ordering system. Children having a school packed lunch still need to bring a drink, and they may bring an extra snack too.
