There are many things outside in the garden.



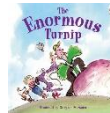
#### The Tiny Seed

<b>Grow</b>	A change to an object. The object usually gets bigger.
<b>Seed</b>	The part of a plant which can grow into a new plant.
<b>Soil</b>	A brown material that seeds and plants can grow in.
<b>Plant</b>	A living thing that grows in soil.
<b>Attach</b>	A way to join materials together.
<b>Sculpture</b>	A solid model created.
