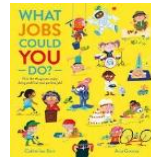
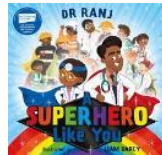
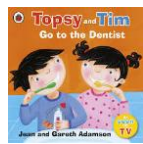


### Understanding the World - Past and Present
